Our operating expenses exceeded our operating income by \$1.392.49 for January, so we will not move money into our reserve fund. However, we will move \$3,714.80 from the BFOF account to the general fund, to cover Capital Campaign expenses that were paid for out of the general fund. Income from class/building use in January was \$178..Bookstore income was \$169.87. Hospitality income was \$138.02.

We will tithe \$1,343.97 in February, based on January donations. Our floating tithe of \$335.99 this month will go to the International Rescue Committee, one of the organizations supporting those affected by the earthquake in Turkiye and Syria, as well as those impacted by the ongoing war in Ukraine.

We also tithe monthly to Unity Worldwide Ministries, Great Lakes Unity Regional Council, Silent Unity, Porchlight, and the Minister's Discretionary Fund that supports congregational needs.

We are prosperous, and grateful for the increasing flow of income and tithing of talents. Thank you for your ongoing support of our ministry through your generous tithes and offerings, and for your vision and intention as we draw our next permanent minister to our community, and provide funding for building and grounds improvements.
